LEVEL 1 INTRODUCTION TO REPLENISHMENT

Explore the fundamentals of Replenishment. Buyers garner a strong understanding of how Manhattan's Replenishment solution builds order quantities. Focus is on the main components of the suggested order quantity: Demand Forecast, Lead-time, Order Frequency and Safety Stock.

OVERVIEW

- Understand Safety Stock, including its components and the effects on ordering

- Discuss tactics for managing vendor brackets and ordering restrictions
- Dive into order cycles and the tools for analyzing order frequency
